By offering unlimited classes, we're able to guarantee that all of the dogs master basic skills. Depending on the pet's progress, participants may attend as many or as few classes as they like."

Focusing on socialization, bonding and positive training techniques, Frogs to Dogs builds "play time" into each group class to facilitate an educational and enjoyable experience for all involved. During the introductory Basic Group Obedience Training Program, dogs learn the basics of sit, down, stay, heel and come, as well as loose leash walking and socialization skills. Once the dog has mastered the basic skills, he's ready for intermediate training, but is also always welcome to re-visit the Basic class. Cost: \$175. New classes begin weekly. When he came to the U.S., he completed animal behavior certification and mastered a variety of training techniques. The Humane Society of the United States recommends all pet owners enroll their dog in a training class, specifically positive reinforcement classes. "Positive training will allow one to control the companion's behavior safely and humanely," states The Society. "And the experience offers a terrific opportunity to enhance the bond one shares with his/her dog."
